




Summer 2019 Youth Mentor Position

We are seeking a creative, adventurous and enthusiastic youth mentor for full-time summer employment and possible future advancement. Are you:

- Passionate about protecting the Earth and living sustainably?
- Excited and prepared to work outside in all weather conditions?
- Knowledgeable and willing to learn about Pacific Northwest native flora and fauna?

Immediate focus will be developing and co-leading summer programs for youth ages 6-10 leading into year-round rites of passage programs for youth ages 10-13. As a Youth Mentor you will be responsible for:

- Working with the director to prepare curriculum and materials for 8 weeks of summer adventures
- Becoming familiar with all aspects of our summer programs
- Co-leading/leading 8 one-week day camp adventures for youth ages 6-10 with a focus on environmental education combined with mythic journey and magical realism
- Mentoring of youth participants, including nonviolent communication and conflict resolution
- Maintenance of camp supplies
- Help with development of new programs and materials
- Helping youth deepen their connections with the earth through outdoor skills and adventure
